## LEGO FIRE FIGHTERS TO THE RESCUE

Bring out the hose, raise the ladder, and test your building skills with this great fire truck.

1. Form a base.



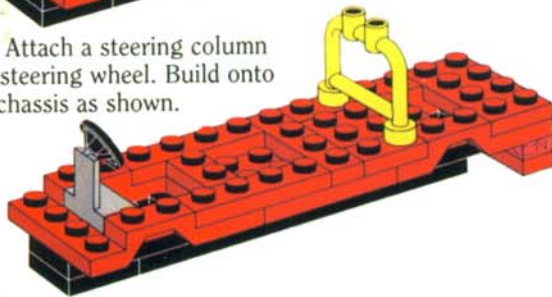
2. Continue to build the base up with another layer of bricks.



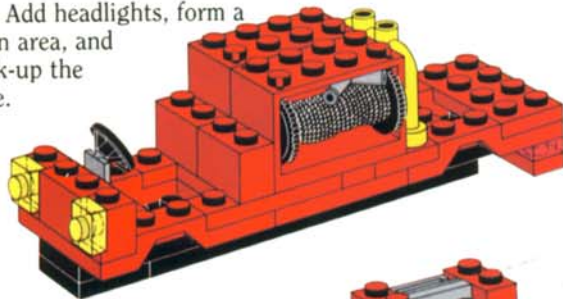
3. Add a chassis.



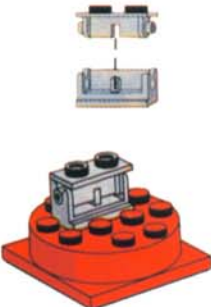
4. Attach a steering column and steering wheel. Build onto the chassis as shown.



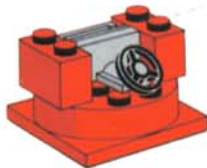
5. Add headlights, form a cabin area, and hook-up the hose.

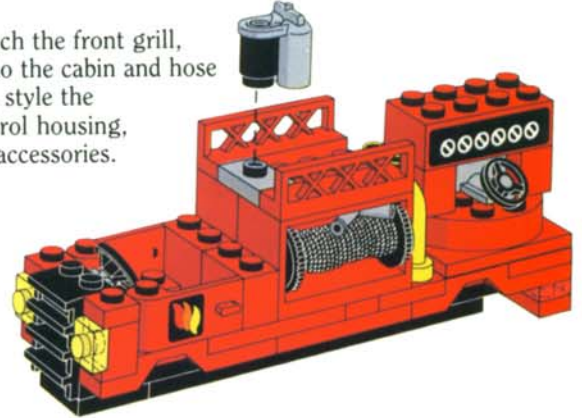

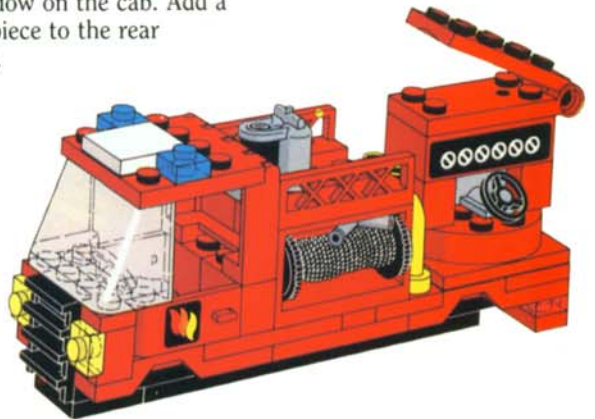

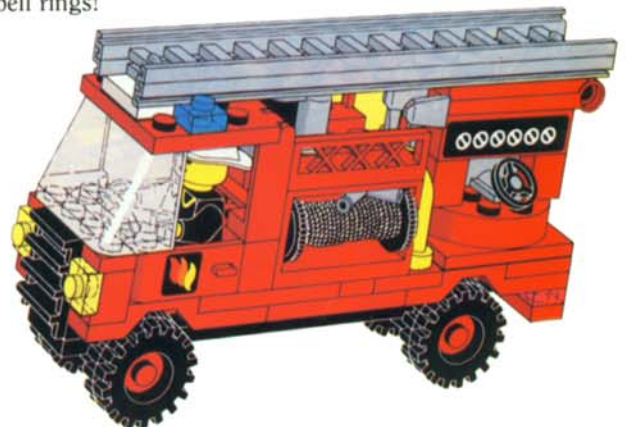
6. Attach the front grill, build onto the cabin and hose housing, style the rear control housing, and add accessories.



7. Position a hinged roof and window on the cab. Add a hinged piece to the rear housing.



8. Place the ladder and wheels on the truck — and you're ready to roll when the fire bell rings!
